Reunion Power and Edison Mission Energy Announce Joint Development Venture

Manchester, VT - Reunion Power LLC (Reunion) and Edison Mission Group (EMG) today announced that they have entered into a Joint Development Agreement for new wind energy projects located in New York State. The agreement includes projects that are currently under development, including the East Hill Wind Farm in Cherry Valley, N.Y.
